Who we work with

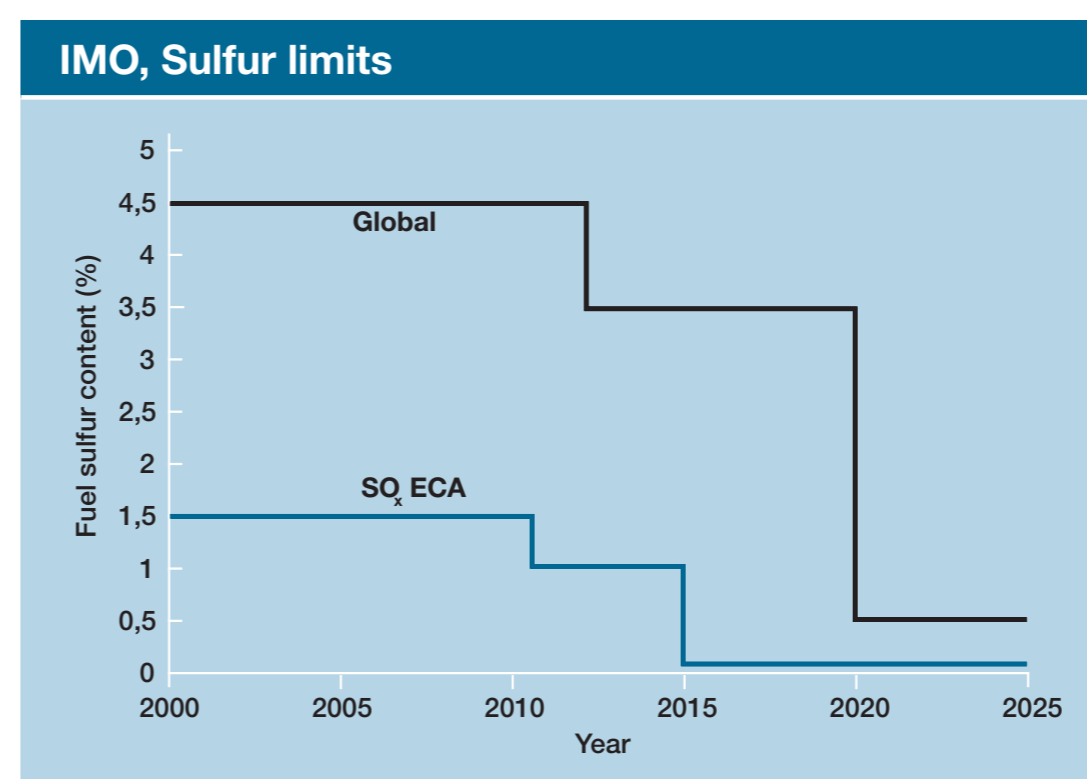
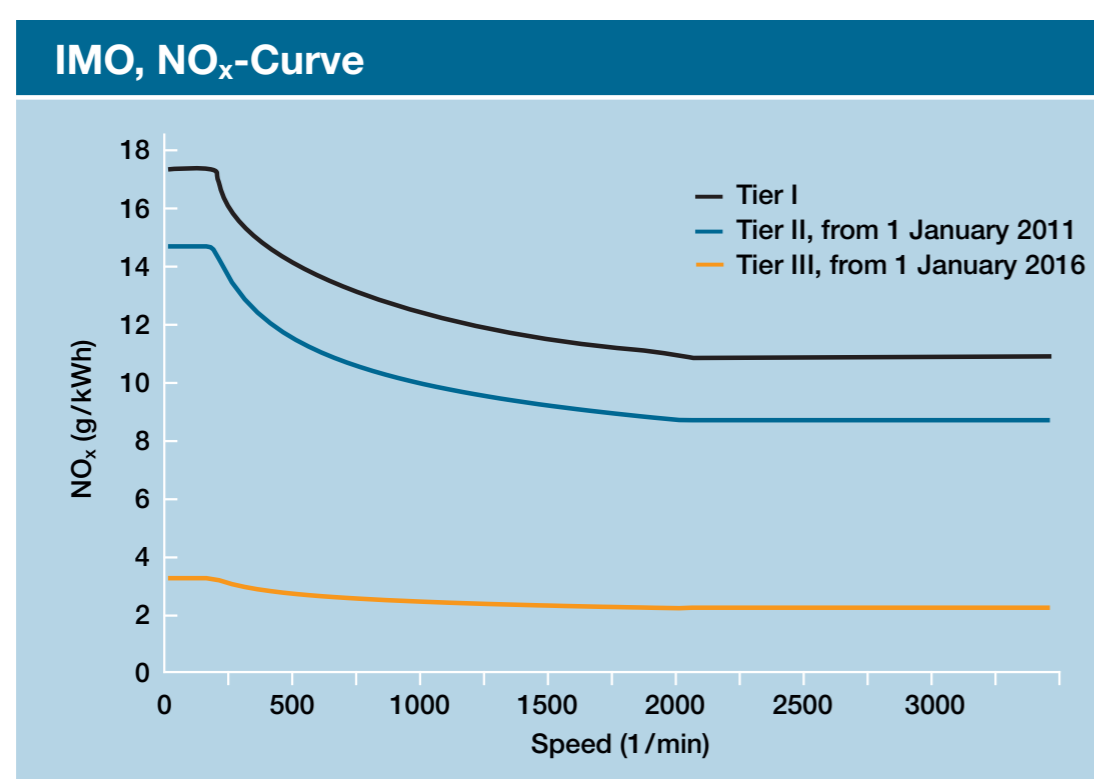
