Under the topic '**Coming Sulphur Regulations – Challenges to the Marine Industry**' the Norwegian CIMAC Association has organised a CIMAC CIRCLE at NorShipping on June 9, 2005, 14:00 h to 16:00 h in the Prime Press Event Centre, located between hall C and D at 1st floor. The panel will be chaired by Einar Sundt, Rolls-Royce Marine AS, and will consist as usual of high-ranking experts from the industry:

There is a growing concern about pollution from industry, as well as from on-land transportation, aviation and shipping. Restrictions on land-based emissions through proposed and existing legislation have resulted in a relative increase of emissions from shipping. From May 2006 sulphur regulations on marine fuels will be effective for the Baltic Sea, and also for the North Sea and English Channel during 2007. The implementation of these new regulations are challenging for the whole marine industry. In this actual CIMAC Circle the panelists will address some major questions covering future marine fuel availability, quality and cost aspects as well as technical and operational challenges from the manufacturers and end-users point of view. After a short presentation by each panelist time will be dedicated to a discussion with the audience. So don't miss this chance to get your questions answered.
