The CIMAC World Congress 2023 has ended – next Congress 2025 in Zurich

After five days of intensive work, over 200 presentations, discussion panels, poster sessions, social events and technical tours, the 30th CIMAC World Congress ended today. More than 700 experts from all over the world attended the Congress.
