The 2010 World Expo was held in Shanghai, over 70 million people from different parts of the world visited this Expo.

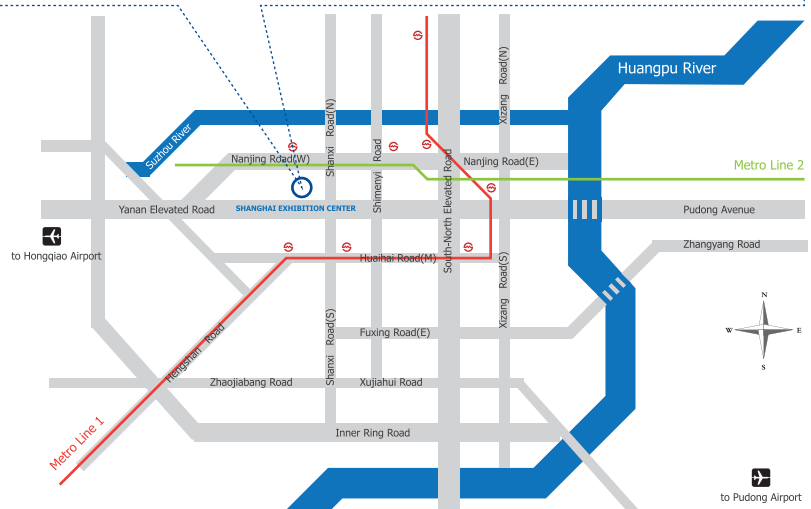
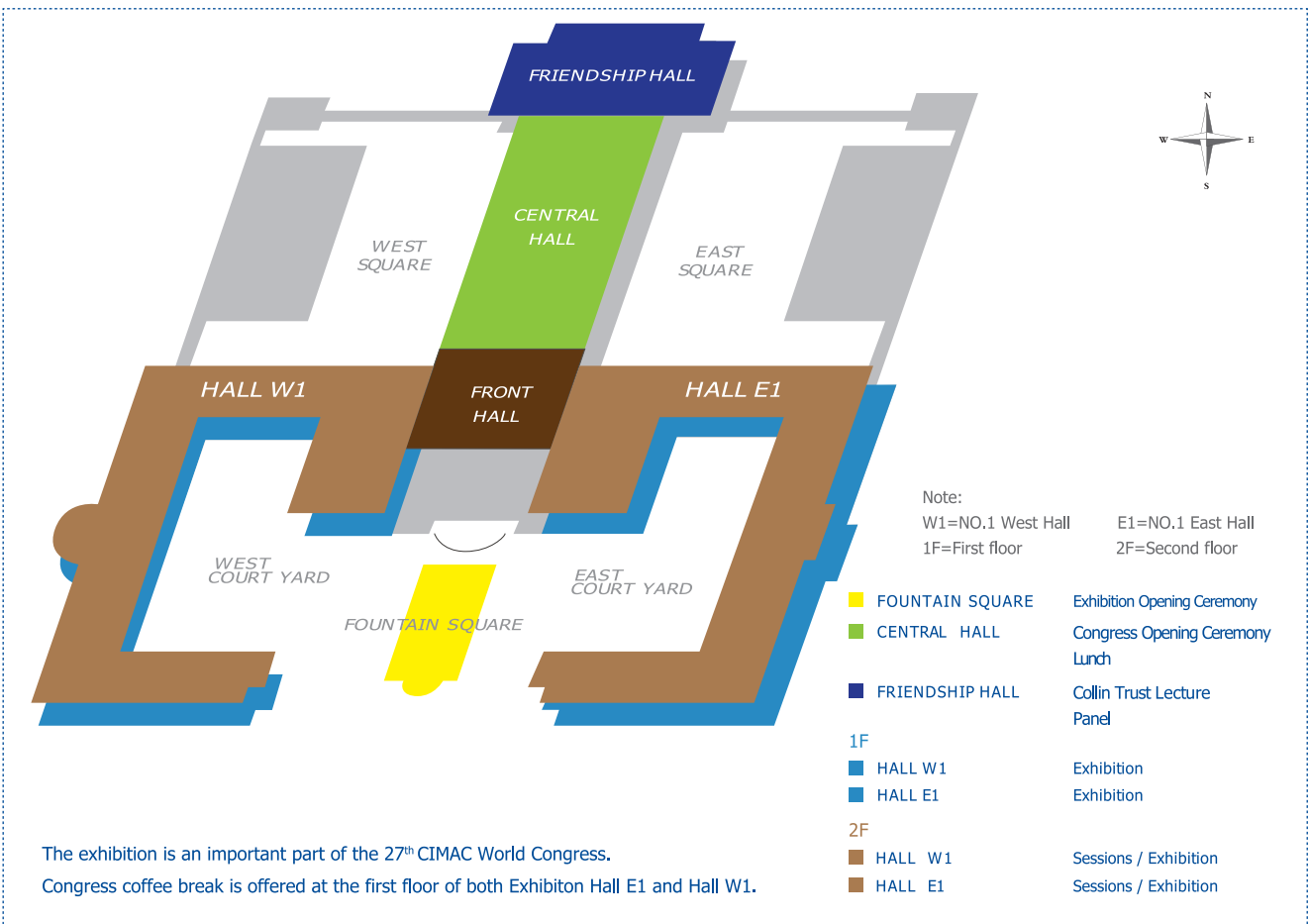
CIMAC Invites the Engine World

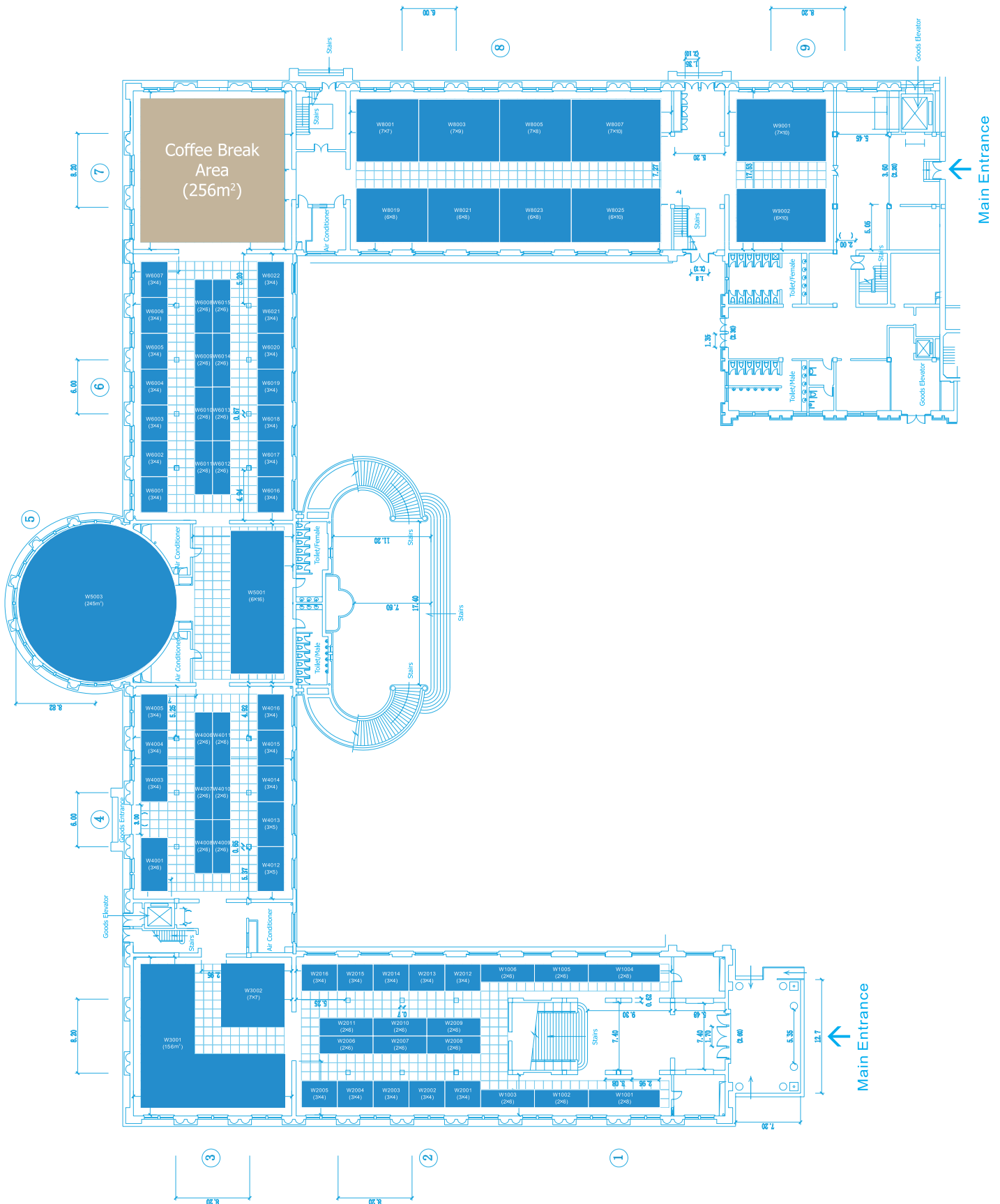
